

## Transfer Guide College of DuPage to Wheaton College

This document is intended to help students who wish to begin at College of DuPage, and later transfer to Wheaton College, plan for courses that will meet Wheaton requirements.

## **Core Competencies:**

**Foreign Language** - Wheaton College requires completion through the Intermediate Level to meet competency. Foreign language classes must be taken in person, not online.

**Oral Skills** - SPEEC 1100 or 2160. Oral Communication courses must be taken in person, not online.

Writing - ENGLI 1101 and 1102. Both are required to fully meet Wheaton's Writing competency.

## Thematic Core

Choose up to 4 of the following categories, which we call themes. A **maximum of 4 themes** can be met with transfer credit. Courses on the list beyond 4 themes would come in as elective credit.

**AAQR (Math)** - MATH 2231 if Calculus is needed for your intended major, otherwise MATH 1432, MATH 1533 or MATH 1635.

**Scientific Practice (Lab Sciences)** - BIOLO 1100, EARTH 1102, PHYSI 1201 or PHYSI 2111. If majoring in Biology, Chemistry or Applied Health Science, take BIOLO 1151 & 1152 and CHEMI 1551 & 1552. We do not recommend taking Anatomy & Physiology courses because they will not meet the requirement for the major at Wheaton. Must be taken with a 3 hour per week inperson lab. Engineering & Physics majors should begin with PHYSI 2111.

Literary Explorations - ENGLI 1130

**Visual & Performing Arts** - ART 1100 and MUSIC 1100 (need both to complete the theme)

Historical Perspectives - HISTO 1110

Philosophical Investigations - PHILO 1100

**Social Inquiry** - ANTHR 1100, ECONO 2202, POLS 1101, PSYCH 1100 or SOCIO 1100

## **Major Courses**

Round out your schedule with entry level courses in a major you are interested in pursuing. Wheaton College requires a certain number of courses in the major be taken at Wheaton, so it is best not to take a large number of major courses.
