Catalyst 1 Program Overview



Spiritual Theme of Catalyst 1:

Theme Scripture of Psalm 95

- This summer's theme for Catalyst 1 is "People of His Pasture."
- Through our Spiritual theme will explore:
 - 1) Q: Who is God? A: He is our King, Creator, Rock
 - 2) Q: Who are we? A: We are sheep and God's people
 - 3) Q: What do we do in response? A: Worship, Praise, Kneel, and Sing
- Campers worked through the book of Matthew during their Morning Watch time, and followed the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ.
- Catalyst 1 students spent Mondays and Wednesdays with their cabins as their leaders lead them through Discipleship Hours (aka Bible Studies) tackling the following themes:
 - 1) What does a relationship with God look like?
 - 2) What does a relationship with myself look like?
 - 3) What does my relationship with others look like?
 - 4) What does a relationship with creation look like?

Key Programmatic Highlights:

- Leadership Wednesdays focusing on Creation, Self, God, and Others
- **Service Areas:** Work across camp and in the community is a foundational pillar of Catalyst 1. Service areas & the corresponding number of campers per work area are as follows: barn, construction, grounds, kitchen, trip locker & kitchen, housekeeping, auto shop. Cabin Leaders join designated work areas in the afternoons from 1:00-5:00 pm.
- **Secret Service:** At the heart of the Catalyst 1 program is service, and every Saturday morning students have the chance to participate in a secret service opportunity.
 - o Saturday July 6th Trail Maintenance (Coordinator Planned)
 - Saturday July 13th TBD (Cabin Leader Planned)
 - Saturday July 20th TBD (Catalyst 1 Student Planned)
 - August July 3rd TBD (Catalyst 1 Student Planned)
- Vespers: Worship is the heartbeat of the HoneyRock experience, so every Sunday all staff and Catalyst students come together for a time of prayer and worship leaving intentional room for the Holy Spirit to move. In addition to all camp vespers Catalyst 1 has the opportunity for student lead Vespers each Wednesday night. This is a chance for Catalyst 1 students to have a chance to lead worship for their own peers.
- Activity Areas: Every Tuesday and Thursday night Catalyst 1 campers are able to participate in all of the classic camp activity areas alongside of

staff including (fishing, mountain biking, climbing, horsemanship, ceramics, water skiing, kayaking, swimming, canoeing, archery, riflery, and crafts).

Trip Details:

- The purpose of the wilderness trips are to experience God through Creation, build leadership skills, and bond together as a cabin.
- Catalyst 1 students embark on a 3 night wilderness trip with in the first week of arrival.
- Catalyst 1 students were taught and equipped to plan their own
 wilderness adventure as a cabin. Each cabin was assigned their first
 campsite, however from there, the group had full agency over their route,
 whether they back packed or canoed, their food they packed, their gear
 they brought, and how they logically completed the adventure.
- Each camper in the cabin participated in becoming the Leader of the Day (LOD) which entailed directional navigation, campsite management and more.
