Res Middle Program Overview



Spiritual Theme of Res Middle:

This year in Res Middle campers were invited to fall deeper in love with Jesus as they learned and responded to how deeply loved they are by our God. "Know that the Lord, he is God! It is he who made us, and we are his" says Psalm 95.

- -In Solid Rock, campers were invited to engage with spiritual disciplines as they imitated Christ in growing in wisdom, stature, favor with God, and favor with man. Campers who chose to participate had the opportunity to memorize Psalm 95, complete a fun run, secretly serve camp, and practice meditative prayer led by their cabin leader.
- In time studying the word individually in Morning Watch and communally in Cabin Impacts, campers engaged with the seven I-am statements in the gospel of John, where Jesus himself tells us who he is.

-Campers were invited to respond with praise as they deepened their
understanding of who God is. At the end of the session campers were given the
space to fill in the following prayer for their session of camp: "Lord, I love you
because you are"

Key Programmatic Highlights of Res Middle:

Throughout the session we delighted in play, community, and adventure. Here are some key moments that you might want to ask your camper about:

- **-Fest:** This is a high energy afternoon spent with lots of silly water play and is a key bonding moment for many of our cabins
- **-Women Camp and Man Camp:** While the other gender is in the woods, we have a couple days of special program looking at our identity in Christ as beloved children.
- **-Worship:** Campers had the chance to worship a lot this summer! A beloved part of every day is camper worship where we dance and praise the Lord. Res Middle celebrated who our God is in Vespers and opening and closing ceremony.
